



Traffic Changes around the MUHC Work Site

Between boulevard Decarie and rue Addington from April to June 2011

Ville de Montréal wishes to inform you of the traffic changes that are now in effect in regard to the construction work on the water mains and sewers around the MUHC's Glen Campus.

Chemin Upper-Lachine and boulevard De Maisonneuve

The south portion of boulevard De Maisonneuve and chemin Upper-Lachine between boulevard Décarie and rue Addington is closed. Traffic is maintained in both directions on the north part of boulevard De Maisonneuve and chemin Upper-Lachine. This work should be completed in early June 2011.

Access to sidewalks and to the bicycle path

For safety reasons, the bicycle path and the sidewalk on the south side of boulevard De Maisonneuve are closed, from boulevard Décarie to avenue Marlowe for the duration of the work. Pedestrians and cyclists must use the sidewalk located on the north side of boulevard De Maisonneuve. Signage specific to pedestrians and cyclists has been posted in the area. For your safety, we ask that you respect this signage.

Rue Saint-Jacques and boulevard Décarie

As of April 12, the work zone on rue Saint-Jacques will extend west and will stop opposite the Mazda dealership. For safety reasons, a new intersection has been created. Traffic at the intersection will be managed by stop signs. **U**-turns are authorized at this intersection.

Access to sidewalks

Due to the work at the intersection, pedestrians must cross at the newly created intersection and connect to a pedestrian corridor located on the south side of Saint-Jacques. Specific signage for pedestrians is in place in the area. For your safety, we ask that you respect this signage.

Access to businesses on avenue Crowley and on boulevard Décarie

Businesses are accessible via avenue Crowley from eastbound chemin Upper Lachine. Drivers are asked to pay special attention to the signage in place in the area.

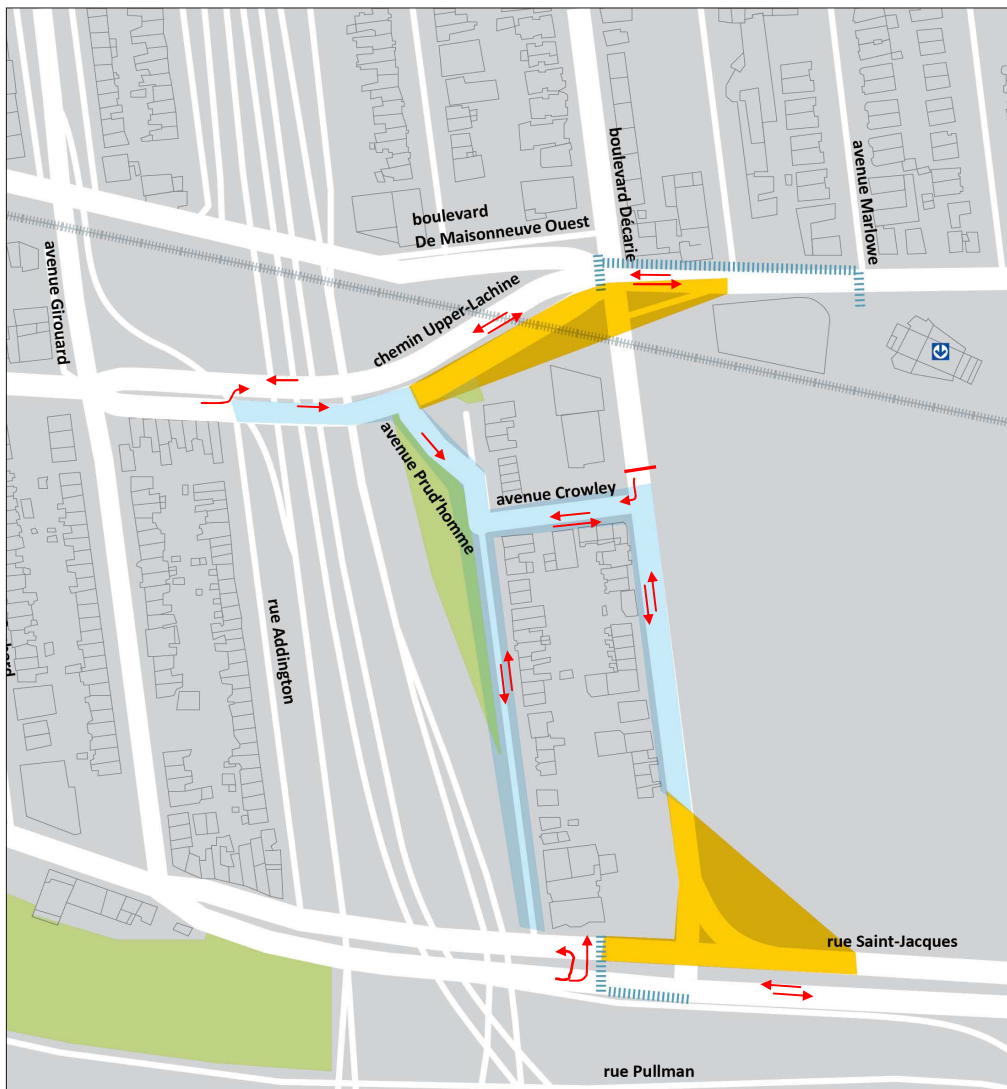
Chemin Upper-Lachine and avenue Girouard Intersection

Traffic lights have recently been upgraded at the intersection of chemin Upper-Lachine and avenue Girouard. Lights for pedestrians have been added to increase the safety of pedestrians and cyclists who cross the intersection.
