Mission

Société des Grands Citoyens honours persons and entities (organizations, businesses and institutions) deserving of citizens' recognition for their accomplishments in a field of endeavour that have an impact locally or beyond the boundaries of the Borough. Any persons or entities having made an important contribution to the community are eligible.

Do you know any person or entity deserving of this honour? Submit their candidature before May 16, 2013.

Selection Criteria

Individuals and entities alike can be eligible for the title of Outstanding Citizen. Candidatures will be examined by a jury in relation to the following two criteria:

- Outstanding contribution in their discipline, occupation or field of endeavour, whether in a volunteer or occupational capacity.
- Notable contribution or dedication to the life of their community.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Irrespective of their field of endeavour, Outstanding Citizen contribute to the development and flourishing of our community. Their accomplishments can have an impact both within and beyond the Borough's boundaries.

As upcoming artists, accomplished athletes, event promoters or volunteers our Outstanding Citizens distinguish themselves by their creative spirit and their resolve.

Because they preserve the environment or because they enhance the architecture of their neighborhood, they help to improve quality of life and have a positive impact on their surroundings.

Whether they be individuals, or community or institutional organizations, it is their social commitment and dedication to the community that makes them stand out.

In the area of innovation, the economy or support to groups, the recognition received by these ambassadors is earned by their audacity and their humanistic convictions.

Société des Grands Citoyens de Côte-des-Neiges—Notre-Dame-de-Grâce rewards the most simple of deeds as well as grander undertakings. It highlights both unassuming excellence and the glorious accomplishments found in daily life.

REGISTRATION FORM

PRESENTATION OF CANDIDATURE FILE

Persons wishing to submit a candidature must prepare a well-documented file corresponding to the presentation elements below:

1. Is this an individual, or an entity (organization, business or institution)?
2. Description of the achievements of the individual or entity. How has the candidate contributed in an exceptional manner to the candidate's discipline, occupation or field of endeavour, whether in a volunteer or occupational capacity?
3. Perceived impact of the candidate's work or deeds within the Borough (or outside it in the case of an ambassador).
4. The life path of the person (education, work or involvement), or the history and mission of the entity.
5. The attached candidate registration form duly completed.

ANALYSIS OF CANDIDATURE FILES

- Handwritten files are not accepted: they must be submitted in printed characters.
- You are invited to attach any document relevant to the candidature application, such as the candidate's C.V., photographs, official letters demonstrating the candidate's involvement, or newspaper articles.
- The deadline for candidature submission is Monday May 13, 2013 at 4:30 pm.
- Analysis of candidature files will be carried out by a multidisciplinary jury.
- Presentation of awards will take place on June 6, 2013.
