

Reopening of the Saint-Jacques exit (A-720 West) on September 2, 2011

Dear Sir or Madam,

The Ville de Montréal is proud to announce the re-opening of the Saint-Jacques exit on Autoroute 720 West as of September 2, 2011.

The work carried out at the intersection of boulevard Décarie and rue Saint-Jacques, which had necessitated the closing of this exit for safety reasons, is now completed.

In the last few months, the Ville de Montréal has built several collector sewers and two water mains, rebuilt the drop structure, redeveloped the intersection and installed new traffic lights. The implementation of this phase represents the end of a critical step in an important project to rebuild municipal infrastructures in preparation for the arrival of the McGill University health Centre.

The Ville de Montréal thanks all motorists and residents for their patience and understanding during this work, which will culminate in Montréal's gaining an international calibre hospital.
