Composition

This committee is composed of 4 or 5 members, a member of Borough Council and members of the Borough's personnel.

Mandate and operation

The committee holds private meetings, three or four times a year, and has the mandate:

- to examine various development projects (Archie-Wilcox and De la Fontaine parks, a public square, the Centre communautaire Marcel-Giroux, a future aquatic centre, etc.)
- to contribute to the considerations aimed at improving the accessibility of commercial establishments and construction sites
- to provide advice on the development of activities for clientele with functional limitations

- Person living with, or accompanying a person with, at least one form of functional limitation (permanent or temporary) OR
- Person with expertise in universal accessibility
