## IMPORTANT NOTICE

### **Subject: Major repairs to parking lot 14 (Borough Hall)**

Dear Residents:

The Verdun Borough will soon be carrying out repairs to parking lot 14, behind Borough Hall. This work is part of one of the four major work projects to entirely redevelop Willibrord park—the area bounded by rue Bannantyne and the Borough Hall building. The other work projects are the development of the children's park (completed), construction of a water retention pond (under way) and the construction of the neighbourhood police station (under way).

This work requires reorganizing or temporarily relocating certain existing parking areas. Enclosed with this notice is a plan (in French) illustrating the relocation of the parking spaces reserved for residents on rue Willibrord and 1<sup>ère</sup> Avenue. Other more minor changes will also be made during the next week.

This work project is expected to take eight (8) weeks to complete (weather permitting).

During certain phases, the contractor will be installing temporary no-parking signs. Please comply with them.

As a temporary measure, parking will be authorized at all times on both sides of the streets, as illustrated on the enclosed plan.

Between September 1 and November 15, 2009 inclusively, the Borough therefore won't be issuing any statements of offence in relation to the regulations on the regular parking signs for maintenance.

Starting November 16, you will have to abide by the parking restrictions stipulated for the winter season; however, you will then be able to check whether parking is allowed by calling the telephone number marked at the bottom of the sign. There you will be informed whether you may park your vehicle or whether you have to comply with the parking restrictions. Every day, starting at 5 p.m., the telephone system will inform you of the parking situation for the following day.

Nevertheless, you must abide by all the other parking restrictions as well (fire hydrants, bus stops, etc.).

Rest assured that we are aware of the inconveniences that such work may cause and that we will take the necessary measures to reduce the negative impacts involved.
