**Subject: Verdun Borough Hall
Start of major construction work**

Dear Residents:

Starting June 1, the Verdun Borough will undertake major construction work behind Borough Hall. As we announced a few months ago, the local police station, commonly called PDQ 16, will be relocated to the basement of Borough Hall, 4555, rue de Verdun.

Initially, this work will result in the closure of the parking facilities along the rear of the building—the spaces reserved for the Mayor and the Councillors, as well as those used by the Borough's vehicles, permit holders and the Communauto service—so that the contractor can set up his worksite there. The spaces reserved for the Council members and the Borough's vehicles will be relocated to the front of Borough Hall, and signs will be posted to this effect. As for permit holders and the Communauto service, they will be able to park their vehicles in the two municipal parking lots behind Borough Hall, starting Monday, June 1.

Later, in early August, there will be a complete closure of the two parking areas located on municipal grounds—along 1^{ère} Avenue and rue Willibrord and used by Borough employees—so that these parking areas can be rebuilt. This work is expected to be completed by the end of this fall. In the meantime, the users of these spaces are being encouraged to opt for alternate means of transportation or to park on nearby streets, while obeying the signs or restrictions in force there.

Rest assured that we are aware of the inconveniences that may be caused by this work aimed at improving your quality of life and that we will be doing our utmost to reduce the negative impacts.
