

Road restructuring at entrances and exits of L'Île-des-Sœurs New Configuration Since August 31

Verdun, September 4, 2009 — As part of the roadwork involved in restructuring the entrances and exits of L'Île-des-Sœurs, the Verdun Borough hereby wishes to remind motorists that a new configuration to access the Bonaventure Expressway and Autoroute 15 North has been in operation since Monday, August 31. New signs to this effect have, in fact, been installed by the Borough.

Route recommended to access the Bonaventure Expressway

Since Monday, August 31, motorists can access the Bonaventure Expressway by taking a new ramp starting from the roundabout at the entrance to L'Île-des-Sœurs and running under the Autoroute 15 overpass.

Route recommended to access Autoroute 15 North

From the southern part of L'Île-des-Sœurs, motorists wanting to take Autoroute 15 North are being encouraged to use boulevard René-Lévesque, rue Jacques-LeBer and Chemin de la Pointe-Nord.
