**Subject: Major road repairs
rues Claude and Joseph between rue de l'Église and rue Hickson**

Dear Residents:

Starting shortly, the Verdun Borough will be carrying out construction work on your street. This work involves replacing the infrastructures (water main and sewer), rebuilding water supply and sewage pipes as well as a complete repair of the road. It is expected that all this work will be completed over the next six (6) weeks (weather permitting).

During certain phases of the work, the contractor will be installing temporary signs prohibiting parking on both sides of the street. Please obey them, for these works as well as for those being completed on nearby streets.

As a temporary measure, parking will be authorized at all times on both sides of the streets, as illustrated on the attach sketch.

The Borough therefore won't be issuing any statements of offence concerning parking restrictions regulated by regular maintenance-related signs. Time limitation on de l'Église will not be enforced and night parking will be allowed. However, you must obey all the other restrictions, for example with regard to no parking next to fire hydrants or bus stops.

For garbage and recycling collections, please place your bags in front of your address, between 10 p.m. the day before and 8 a.m. on the day of the collection. The contractor's employees at this worksite will look after pick-up. The two collections will be carried out once a week, **on Tuesday**, in your area. You will have to continue using black bags for garbage and blue bags for recyclables.

The mail delivery may be interrupted while the work is under way. In that case, you will have to go and pick up your mail at the Canada Post postal station located at 530 rue de l'Église.

Rest assured that we are aware of the inconveniences that this work may cause and that we will take the necessary measures to reduce the negative impacts.
