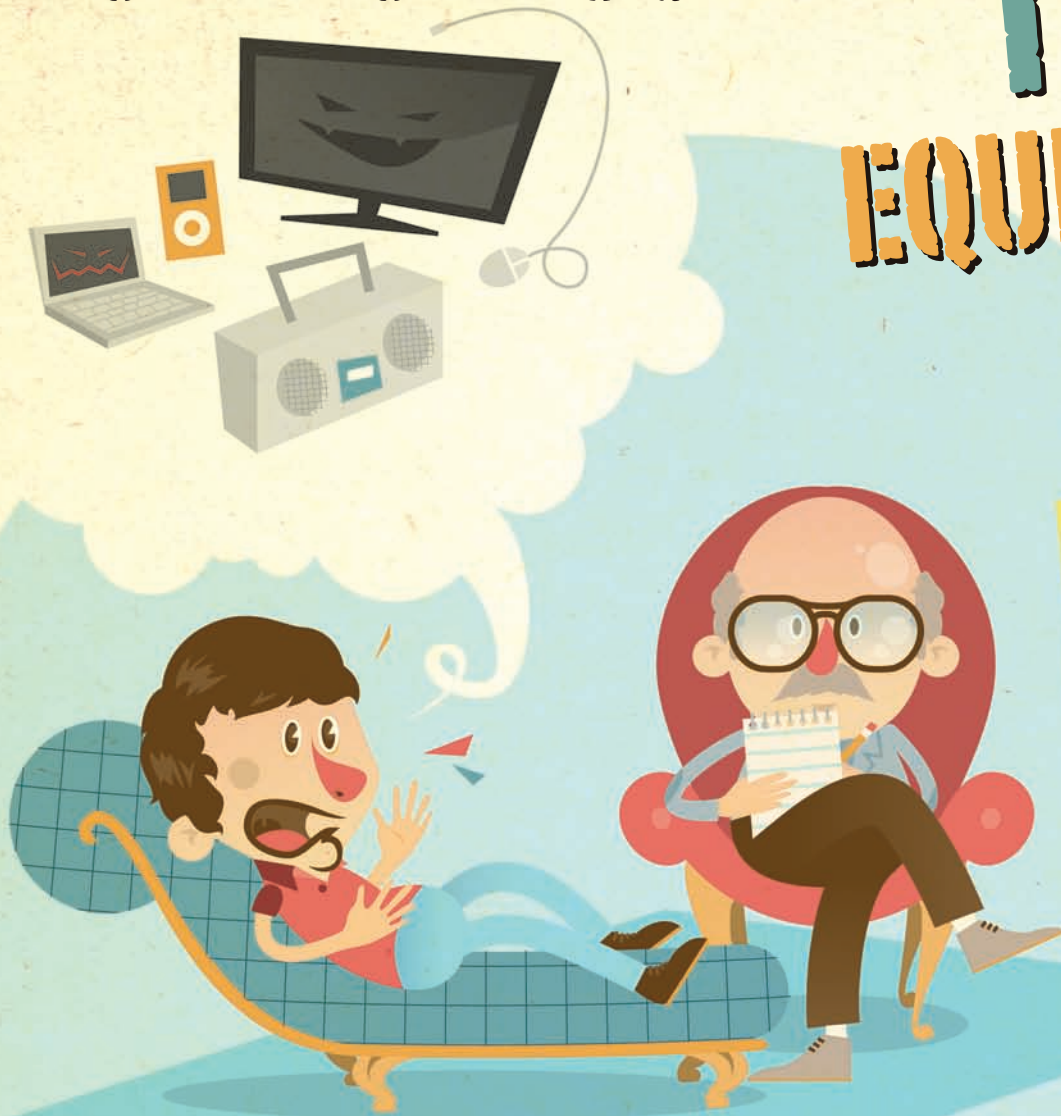

List of ICT equipment accepted:

- > personal computers and laptops
- > CRT and flat screens (LCDs and plasma)
- > mice, keyboards, cables and other computer components
- > printers
- > drives and scanners
- > radios, sound systems, stereos
- > televisions and televisions with built-in DVD or VHS players
- > DVD and VHS players

It should be noted that ICT equipment doesn't necessarily have to be in working order. It may be damaged, but without parts being broken (for example, no broken glass).
