Competition rules

How to enter?

Send a maximum of four photographs to the Centre d'histoire de Montréal. **For each photograph**, you must fill out and sign the attached coupon or a facsimile of it. You must mention of the place where the photo was taken, your name and address, and the category in which you wish to enter each photograph.

Who can enter?

The competition is open to everyone.

When to enter?

From June 1st to November 8, 2009. The photographs must be mailed or brought to the Centre d'histoire de Montréal, 335 Place D'Youville, Montreal, QC H2Y 3T1, or to the Centre d'histoire's administrative offices at 410 rue St. Nicolas, Bureau 124, Montreal, QC H2Y 2P5.

What are the technical specifications?

The photographs must be on a paper support. CD supports are not accepted. Maximum dimensions are 35 cm (14 in.) x 28 cm (11 in.).

What to photograph?

Since the beginning of the 20th century, Montreal has produced a striking modern architectural heritage, with futuristic styles that occasionally clash in the prevailing eclecticism of a North-American urban centre. From Place Ville-Marie to Westmount Square, without forgetting Habitat 67, modern architecture is an element of our cultural

heritage that subtly influences our daily lives. Sky-scrappers, religious and educational institutions, banks and caisses populaires, and one-family dwellings between 1930 and 1970 are so many references to the dreams, transformations, and innovations that have shaped contemporary Quebec.

Author's rights

The signing of the coupon that must accompany each photograph constitutes the ceding, freely and indefinitely, of a license that allows the City of Montreal to use and reproduce the photographs submitted in this competition in any manner and on any support it wishes. It is also the participant's guarantee that he or she is the veritable author of the photograph, or the authorized user of it. The photographer's name will obligatorily appear whenever his or her photograph is used.

Evaluation of the photographs

The photographs will be judged by a jury for framing, technical quality, choice of subject, and sensitivity of treatment.

The winners will be informed of the results within one month after the competition closes.

A selection of photos will be exhibited at the Centre d'histoire from September 22, 2010 until March 13, 2011.
