Opportunity for the urban agglomeration of Montréal to create a food policy council

The [Commission sur le développement social et la diversité montréalaise](#) invites the population to take part in a public consultation regarding the opportunity, for the urban agglomeration of Montréal, to create a food policy council.

On the one hand, this consultation will give the *Service de la diversité sociale et des sports de la Ville de Montréal* the opportunity to present the concept of an FPC, as well as the Montréal area's existing strengths and the conditions that must be put into place to ensure the success of an FPC.

On the other hand, citizens and representatives of organizations will be invited to inform the committee of their expectations, but also of their contribution to an eventual FPC, particularly in regards to:

- The operating conditions of a Montréal FPC;
- The anticipated concrete results for citizens, particularly those who are most vulnerable.
