

Eligibility criteria:

- Having been a resident of Montréal at least for the past 3 months.
- Having a household income that falls below the thresholds shown here*.
- Having paid the microchipping fee at the SPCA appointment.
- Having obtained or renewed their dog or cat permit within 5 business days following sterilization, either online at **montreal.ca** or in person at an Accès Montréal office or a Ville de Montréal service point.

or
a photocopy of an invoice dated more than 3 months, showing a valid residential address.
For example, if your application is filed on April, 1st, the bill must be dated January 1st or earlier.
- 3- Proof of income for every household member with an income (federal notice of assessment or tax return filed for 2018)
or
proof of Québec social security benefits.

Microchip

At the time of your sterilization appointment, you must have your pet microchipped, if it isn't already done. If your pet is not already microchipped, a microchip will be implanted, and you will be charged \$15 for the service.

Mandatory permit

If you do not have a valid permit, you must obtain one or renew the existing one with the city within the 5 business days following the sterilization of your pet. Cat: \$12 \$ | Dog: \$28

Free services

Sterilization, basic vaccines and deworming are free of charge.
