Replacement of street lighting on the following avenues: Wiseman, Manseau and Outremont

**** NEW STARTING DATE OF WORK PROJECT**

Work operations now rescheduled to start on: November 13, 2018

As part of the project to optimize the neighbourhood and develop Université de Montréal's future MIL campus, Ville de Montréal is **undertaking work to bring street lighting up to standard** on the following avenues:

- **Outremont** (from Van Horne to the Outremont site)
- **Wiseman** (from Van Horne to the Outremont site)
- **Manseau** (from Outremont to Wiseman)

Work operations, to be carried out **on an alternating basis, on one side of the street at a time**, will take a few days to complete on each street and are expected to be finished in **about three weeks' time**, on all avenues.

This new street lighting will produce less glare than the previously installed type, while complying with the latest standards in this regard. The main change is the colour of the lighting—3,000 K (warm white) instead of 4,000 K (pure white).

Work schedule:

- Work operations will be carried out Monday - Friday, 7:30 a.m. – 7 p.m.

Impact of the work operations

- **Traffic** - **No impact on traffic** and no road closures
- **Parking** - **No-parking signs** will be posted at least 12 hours prior to the work operations. Please make sure you obey the signs in place.
- **Pedestrians** - Pedestrian traffic on sidewalks will be maintained. Refer to the signs in place.
- **Access** - Access to residences and businesses will be maintained.
- **Buses** - No impact on bus routes
- **Cyclists** - Cyclists will be able to travel safely.
- **Waste and recycling collection** - Collection schedules will be maintained during the work operations. Identify your bins so that they can be returned to the front of your building.
