MIL Montréal (Outremont Site and Surrounding Area) – Rehabilitation Work at the Site of the Former Municipal Roadwork Yard

Start of work project: December 3, 2018

Winter break: December 22, 2018 - January 11, 2019

End of work project: end of September 2019

Working hours: Monday - Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Nature of work operations

As of December 3, 2018, Ville de Montréal will begin demolition work on the buildings of the former Outremont roadwork yard as well as soil rehabilitation.

Once this work project has been completed, a neighbourhood park (name to be announced), located between Avenue Wiseman, Boulevard Dollard, Avenue Ducharme and Avenue Thérèse-Lavoie-Roux (main road), will be created.

Impacts of the work operations

- Traffic: The work will not cause any obstructions on the roads in the area.
 Construction trucks will access the worksite area via Chemin Bates,
 Avenue Thérèse-Lavoie-Roux and Boulevard Dollard.
- Noise and dust: Measures will be taken to limit the impact of nuisances on the neighbourhood.
- Tree-cutting operations: The City will be cutting down trees during this work project in order to decontaminate the soil. It should be noted that many trees, shrubs and other plants will be planted in setting up the neighbourhood park, in order to improve residents' quality of life.
