Work Project to Improve Sewage and Drinking Water System, Roads, Lighting and Traffic Lights

Intersection Avenue Van Horne and rue Westbury

Ville de Montréal hereby wishes to inform you that the work being carried out along avenue Van Horne requires the closure of the intersection of avenue Van Horne and rue Westbury for a week, starting September 10, 2018.

Reminder of work operations

In 2018, the work will be carried out only on the north side of avenue Van Horne, between boulevard Décarie and rue Victoria. Work operations at the intersections will also be required.

In 2019, the work project will continue along the north side of avenue Van Horne, between boulevard Décarie and rue Victoria. Work operations will also take place at the intersections, and final paving will be carried out throughout the area.

Work schedule

- Monday Friday, 7 a.m. 7 p.m., and weekends, 10 a.m. 6 p.m.
- Evening and night work may be necessary.
- The work project will come to a halt in December 2018 and resume in April 2019.

Impacts

- **Traffic**: Only one west-bound traffic lane remains open at all times on Avenue Van Horne, between boulevard Décarie and rue Victoria. Complete closure of intersection Avenue Van Horne and rue Westbury. Local access by rue Kent
- **Parking**: Restrictions in and around the worksite area while the work operations are being carried out
- Access: At all times, access to homes and establishments will be maintained, except during excavations and sidewalk repairs. Residents concerned will be notified accordingly.
- Limited mobility: Call 514 872-3777 (*Info-travaux* hot line). Our agents will ask you for your name, address and telephone number. The project managers will contact you as soon as possible.
- **Moving**: If you have moving plans for the next few weeks, please phone our liaison officer to coordinate access to your home: **Pierre Joyal** at **514 262-1539**.
- Noise and dust: There may be dust and noise generated by comings and goings of trucks in the worksite area.
- Household waste and recycling collections: Bins and bags will be relocated outside the worksite area by the contractor on collection days. Please don't forget to identify your bins.

The City is aware of the inconveniences that this work project may cause and is taking all necessary measures to keep the impacts to a minimum.
