Borough of Côte-des-Neiges-Notre-Dame-de-Grâce and City of Côte Saint-Luc

Sewer, Water, Road and Lighting Operations on Boulevard Cavendish

Night and weekend work

Ville de Montréal hereby wishes to inform you that it will be carrying out waterworks operations that will require the complete closure of the area around the intersection of Chemin de la Côte-Saint-Luc and boulevard Cavendish from Friday, September 7 at noon to Monday, September 10 at 5 a.m. (24 hours a day). This time frame will make it possible to reduce the impact on traffic to a minimum on these major roads.

Traffic

Friday, September 7, at noon - Monday, September 10, at 5 a.m.

 Complete closure of the area around the intersection of Chemin de la Côte-Saint-Luc and boulevard Cavendish, as well as boulevard Cavendish between Chemin de la Côte-Saint-Luc and avenue de Chester (see diagram over).

Road users will be prompted to take alternate routes using the signs that will be posted in the area.

Impacts of the work operations

- Interruption of water supply: Residents and businesses will be notified 48 hours in advance if the work requires water shut-offs. The quality of the drinking water will not be affected by the work and you can therefore consume it without risk.
- On-street parking: Parking restrictions will be applied in the vicinity as well as in the worksite area.
- Access to buildings: At all times, pedestrian access to the buildings located around the site will be maintained. Sidewalks will generally be accessible, but may be obstructed in some phases.
- Limited mobility: Call 514 872-3777 (Info-Travaux hot line). Our agents will ask you for your name, address and phone number. The project managers will then contact you as soon as possible.
- **Noise and dust**: Possibility of dust and noise produced by the comings and goings of trucks in the worksite area as well as by the machinery used. Watering operations will be carried out when required.
- Public transit: Public transit will be maintained, but schedules and routes may change. Contact STM-INFO (by phone at 514 786-4636 or online at www.stm.info).
- Collections: Waste collection and recycling schedules will be maintained throughout the work project. It is important to identify the bins so that they can be returned to the front of the corresponding homes or businesses. Unidentified bins will not be returned and will remain at the collection point near the site. The Borough may then decide to dispose of them to ensure the cleanliness of your environment.

Ville de Montréal is aware of the inconveniences and thanks you for your cooperation.

Residents will receive subsequent communications to inform them of the progress of the work.
