Winter break on boulevard Cavendish


Ville de Montréal hereby wishes to inform you that the work projects on boulevard Cavendish, between avenue Fielding and Chemin de la Côte-Saint-Luc, will be suspended for the winter, starting on December 21, 2018.

Two short operations are planned between now and the Winter break:

- Between Saturday evening, December 15 and Sunday evening, December 16, 2018:
 - Complete closure of the westbound lane on Chemin de la Côte-Saint-Luc, between avenues Borden and Robinson <u>with traffic maintained</u> in both directions on Southside lane over the median strip
- Between Tuesday, December 18 and Wednesday, December 19, 2018, in the evening:
 - Closure of the Cavendish/Fielding intersection
 - Detour route indicated

The area will be demobilized after these operations. Traffic lanes and parking spaces will be reopened while the work projects are suspended during the winter months. The work will resume next year.

The Ville de Montréal is aware of the inconveniences that these work projects may have caused and is taking all necessary measures to minimize their impacts. We thank you for your valuable cooperation.
