Peel Reconstruction and Redevelopment Project

Work operations between avenue du Docteur-Penfield and avenue des Pins to upgrade underground municipal power line network

Starting: June 11

Ending: in approximately 5 weeks

The Commission des services électriques de Montréal (CSEM) is carrying out work operations to upgrade the underground municipal power line network, by replacing one manhole between avenue du Docteur-Penfield and avenue des Pins. This second phase of the work project is expected to take approximately five weeks to complete, starting June 11, 2018.

Traffic obstructions

This work will require the partial closure of rue Peel at all times, between avenue Docteur-Penfield and avenue des Pins. Only one lane southbound will be open to road users. Traffic will be restored south of avenue du Docteur-Penfield

Pedestrians will be able to walk in the worksite area and to access institutions, shops and other commercial establishments as well as homes. Where the sidewalk is obstructed, a protected accessway will be provided along the roadway.

Impacts of the work project

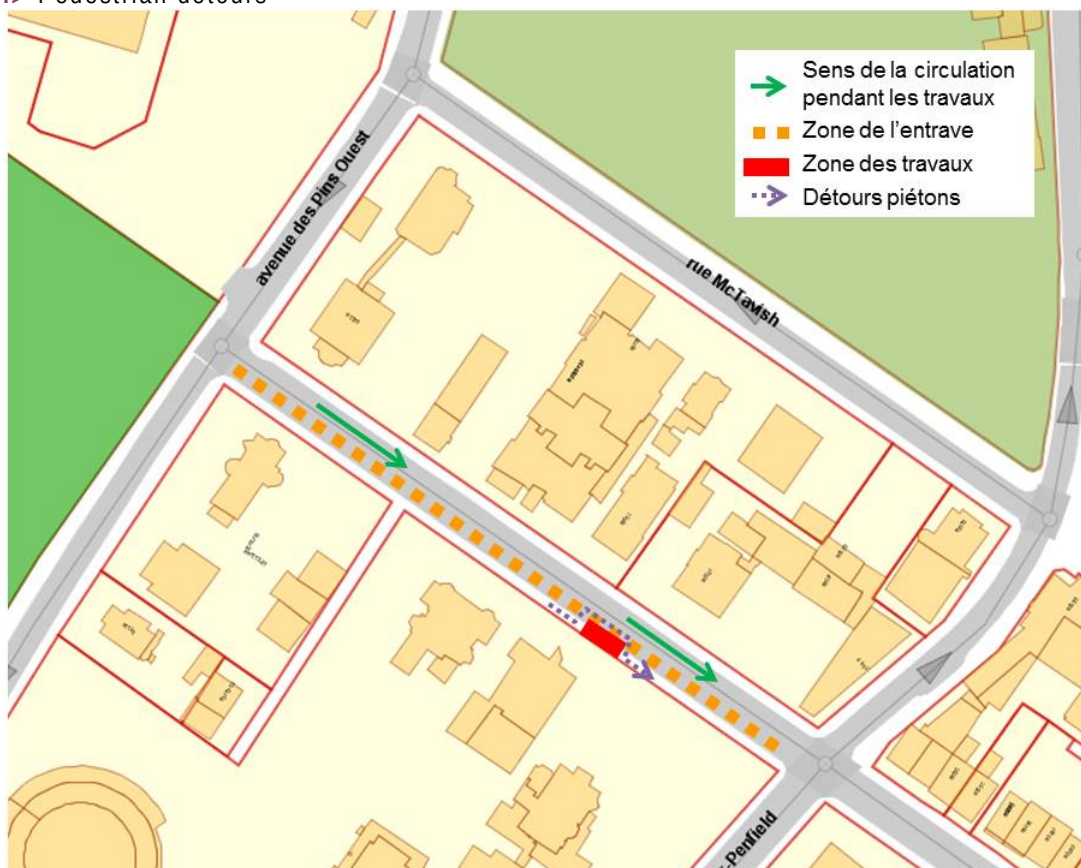
- **On-street parking:** Parking will be prohibited on both sides of the street, between Docteur-Penfield and des Pins.
- **Access to buildings:** At all times, pedestrian access to buildings located in the area around the worksite will be maintained.
- **Hydro-Québec customer service:** The work operations do not require any interruption in electricity distribution or telecommunications service. In case of a power outage, please notify your service provider as you would normally do.
- **Noise and dust:** Rock excavation and demolishing existing concrete structures will require the occasional use of jackhammers, causing noise, dust and vibrations.
- **BIXI:** Some stations may be removed. For more information, please contact BIXI customer service: 514 789-2494, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, or montreal.bixi.com.
- **Garbage and recycling collections:** The contractor will relocate bins and bags for pick-up outside the work area on collection days. Please identify your bins to ensure they are returned to you after the collection.
