Rebuilding of two overpasses on Boulevard de l'Île-des-Sœurs

Start of work

The Ville de Montréal wishes to inform you that work on the reconstruction project of two overpasses on Boulevard de l'Île-des-Sœurs will begin on May 25.

The resumption of construction work is part of the Québec government's plan to reopen various economic sectors during the COVID-19 pandemic. This resumption of work is a clear sign of the city's economic recovery which is being deployed while respecting the prevention conditions recommended by Québec's public health authorities.

The city will put measures in place on construction sites to prevent the risk of contamination for workers and other people at or near the sites. The city would like to remind everyone that infection control is everyone's responsibility.

The city will assess the situation regularly and ensure that all measures recommended by the Direction régionale de santé publique are implemented.

Project duration and work schedule

The work is scheduled to be carried out over two years: 2020 and 2021.

- **2020:** May 25 to fall. Work on the east structure.
 - *Work break during the winter. Fall 2020 to spring 2021.*
- **2021:** Spring to fall. Work on the west structure.

Work schedule

- Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Some work may be carried out during the night or on Saturdays.

Nature of the work

- Demolition and reconstruction of the two existing bridges (including landscaping and lighting).
- Relocation of the sewer pipes under the bridges.
- Reconstruction of the road surface and the sidewalks of Boulevard de l'Île-des-Sœurs between Rue Corot and Rue Darwin.

Location of work (see map on back)

- Boulevard de l'Île-des-Sœurs between Rue Corot and Rue Darwin.

Traffic

- One lane will remain open in both directions due to the creation of a contraflow lane on the structure on the opposite side from where the work is being carried out (between Rue Berlioz and Rue Elgar).

Night-time work – Night of May 25 to 26

Operations to install work zones and barriers will be carried out at night to minimize the impact on traffic.

Tree removal

The trees near Boulevard de l'Île-des-Sœurs will need to be cut down to allow for the installation of the new sewer and water pipes. These operations will be carried out in the week of May 25.

Anticipated impact of this work

- **Parking:** Restrictions will apply in the work zone and surrounding area.
- **Public transit:** Temporary relocation of stops, and schedule and route changes. Contact: STM-INFO (514-786-4636 or www.stm.info/en).
