

Borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro

Waterworks, Road, Street Lighting and Traffic Light Project on Boulevard de Pierrefonds

Within the scope of the work begun at the end of May, please note that from August 6 to the end of September, boulevard de Pierrefonds, heading northeast, will be closed to traffic between boulevard Gouin and boulevard des Sources. Alternate routes will be offered to road users by means of signs that will be installed. Please note that boulevard des Sources will be partially closed to traffic. At all times, at least one traffic lane will remain open in each direction.

Work schedule

Work crews will be on site Monday - Friday, 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. If necessary, the contractor may work some weekends and/or at night.

Impacts of the work project

- Water shut-offs: Residents and businesses will be notified 48 hours in advance if the work operations require water shut-offs. The quality of the drinking water will not be affected by this work project and you can therefore consume it without any risk.
- On-street parking: Parking restrictions will be enforced in and around the worksite area.
- Access to buildings: At all times, pedestrian access to the buildings located around the worksite will be maintained.
- Public transit: Public transit will be maintained; however, schedules and routes may be modified. Contact STM-INFO at 514 786-4636 or consult this service online at www.stm.info.
- Collections: Waste and recycling collection schedules will be maintained throughout this work project. It is important to identify your bins so that they can be returned to the corresponding homes and businesses. Unidentified bins will not be returned and will remain at the collection point near the worksite. The Borough may then decide to dispose of them in order to ensure the cleanliness of your environment.

Residents will receive subsequent communications to inform them of the progress of the work operations.
