Closure of Saint-Zotique/Saint-Hubert intersection, from November 13, 2018 until the end of the month

As part of a work blitz, Ville de Montréal hereby wishes to inform you that the Saint-Zotique/Saint-Hubert intersection will be closed to traffic starting at 7 a.m. on Tuesday, November 13, until the end of the month.

These work operations, which will make it possible, in particular, to complete the reconstruction of sewer and water pipes between Jean-Talon and Saint-Zotique streets, may require **temporary water shut-offs**. Residents concerned will receive a notice in this regard 48 hours beforehand.

It should be noted that the Bélanger/Saint-Hubert intersection is also closed to traffic, but will be completely reopened on November 22, at 10 p.m.

Detour roads

Eastbound

 Motorists travelling eastbound on Bélanger and Saint-Zotique will have to make a detour via Avenue De Chateaubriand and will be prompted to take Beaubien.

Westbound

 Drivers travelling westbound on Bélanger and Saint-Zotique will have to detour via Avenue Christophe-Colomb and will be prompted to use Beaubien as well.

Local traffic

When the Saint-Zotique/Saint-Hubert intersection is closed, only local traffic will be allowed on Saint-Hubert, between Saint-Zotique and Beaubien.

It should be noted that since August 20, Saint-Hubert, between Jean-Talon and Saint-Zotique, has been closed to motor vehicle traffic.

Pedestrian crossings and access to commercial establishments

Pedestrian crossings will be set up at the Bélanger/Saint-Hubert and Saint-Zotique/Saint-Hubert intersections.

It should be remembered that commercial establishments are accessible at all times.

Access to Rue Saint-André and to the alley west of Rue Saint-Hubert

Throughout the work project, Rue Saint-André and the alley between Rue Saint-Hubert and Avenue De Chateaubriand will be accessible to merchants and residents. Deliveries can therefore be made without any problems.

The contractor's working hours

The contractor works mainly Monday - Friday, 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. However, to limit the length of the time of the various obstructions, the contractor may have to work on Saturdays and evenings until 11 p.m.

Ville de Montréal is aware of the inconveniences that these work operations are causing and thanks you for your cooperation.
