Redevelopment of Rue Saint-Hubert

Work Suspended for the Holidays, Resuming in January

Ongoing work operations on Rue Saint-Hubert, between Jean-Talon and Saint-Zotique, will be suspended as of December 22 and will resume on January 7, 2019.

During this period of time, the following street intersections will be reopened to motor vehicle traffic:

- Jean-Talon / Saint-Hubert (no obstructions during this time)
- Bélanger / Saint-Hubert (one lane open in each direction; obstruction on the south side to allow the recently poured concrete to harden)
- Saint-Zotique / Saint-Hubert (no obstructions during this time)

It should also be noted that Rue Saint-Hubert, between Rue Saint-Zotique and Rue Jean-Talon, will remain closed to motor vehicle traffic. Pedestrians, however, will be able to use the sidewalks and corridors provided for them as well as the new crossings that will make it easier for them to get from one side of the street to the other.

We wish to mention as a reminder that businesses will remain accessible at all times. The holiday season is a wonderful opportunity to encourage the Saint-Hubert merchants offering a wide range of goods and services.

Replacement of pipes now completed

Since August 20, the work undertaken by Ville de Montréal has made it possible to replace sewer and water pipes, among other work operations as well as water service entrances to each building. On January 7, work operations will resume and will be carried out on underground electrical equipment.

Ville de Montréal is aware of the inconveniences that such work operations cause and thanks you for your cooperation.
