Traffic and parking


- Partial closure of Rue Beaubien Ouest, between St-Urbain and de l'Esplanade. Parking will not be permitted.
- Local traffic only allowed on Rue Waverly, between Rue Beaubien and the end of Rue Waverly (south of Rue St-Zotique). Access to the parking lot will be possible as well as the unloading of deliveries. Some parking spaces could be occupied by the work.

- Alternative arrangements have been planned to allow cyclist traffic.
