Start-Up of the Tunnel Boring Machine on Sundays, from August 12 to September 28

Ville de Montréal hereby wishes to inform you that some specific work operations will be carried out on Sundays, from August 12 to September 28.

The tunnel boring machine digging deep underground between rue William and rue Saint-Maurice **does not produce any noise above ground**. So that it does not get stuck in the ground by remaining motionless too long, it will be put into operation on Sundays. This measure will make it possible not only to carry out this work with a tunnel boring machine (which is faster and less invasive), but also to avoid prolonging this essential phase of the work project.

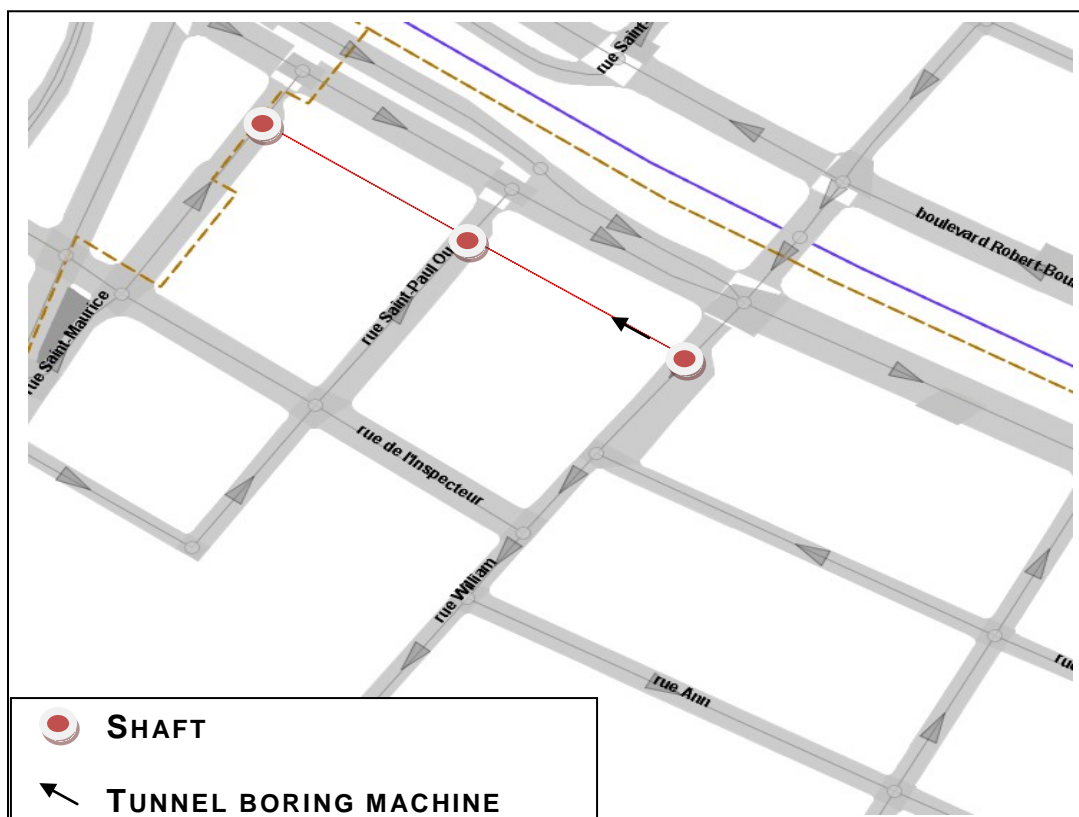
Please note that in order to reduce impacts on Sundays:

- There will be no trucking operations.
- Only one crane will be in operation in order to reduce noise as much as possible.

- Monday – Saturday, 7 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- Sunday, 8 a.m. – 7 p.m.
