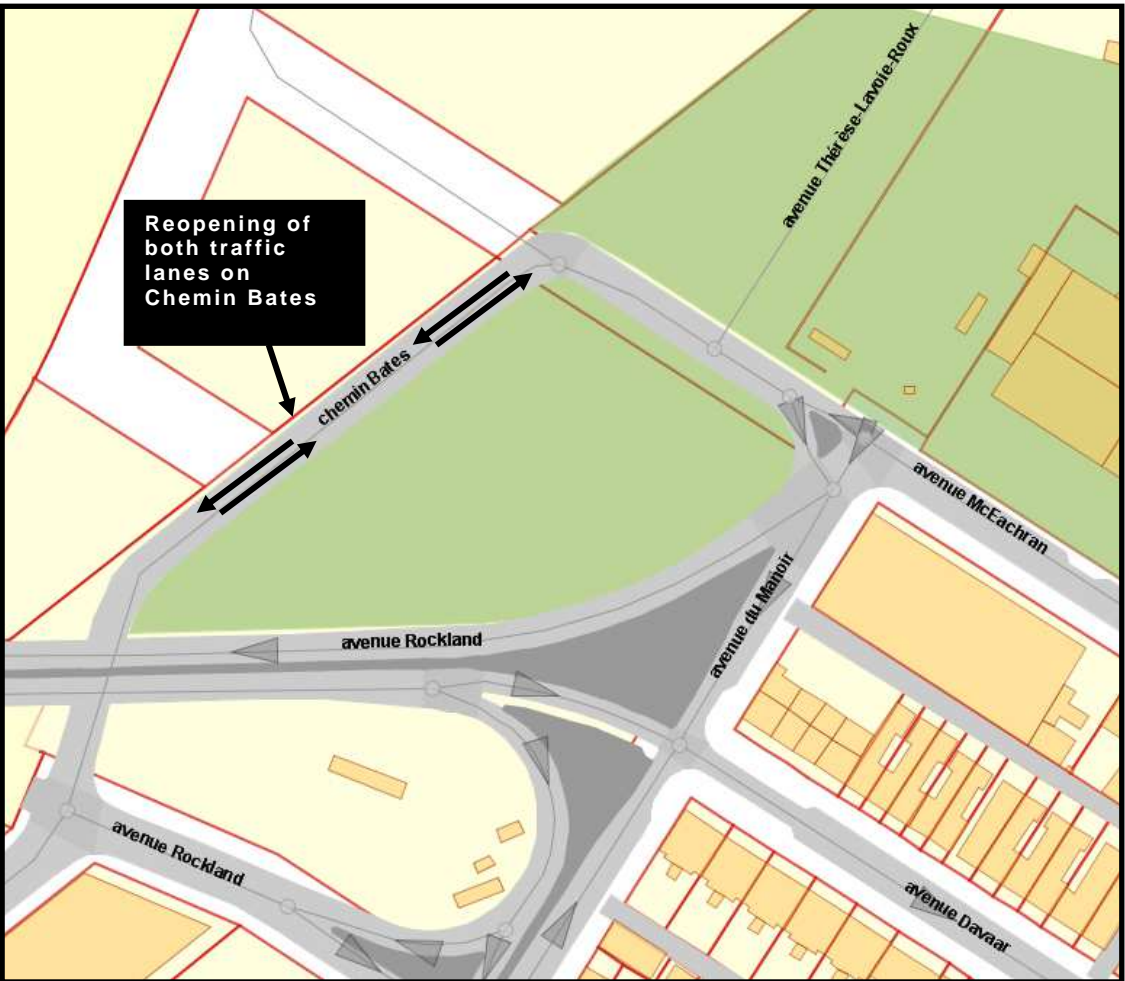
Reopening of Chemin Bates in both directions, starting Friday, November 16

Ville de Montréal will be re-opening Chemin Bates in both directions. This also involves reopening Avenue McEachran, between Chemin Bates and Avenue du Manoir.

New avenue: Thérèse-Lavoie-Roux

Since October, the MIL Montréal sector (Outremont site) has had a new main thoroughfare—avenue Thérèse-Lavoie-Roux—which will run between Avenue McEachran to the west and Avenue Durocher to the east. The majority of the facilities will be completed by November 23, 2018. The work project will be suspended during the winter months and then additional work operations will be carried out next spring.
