Route Westcroft

Between Rue Sherbrooke and
Avenue Elm

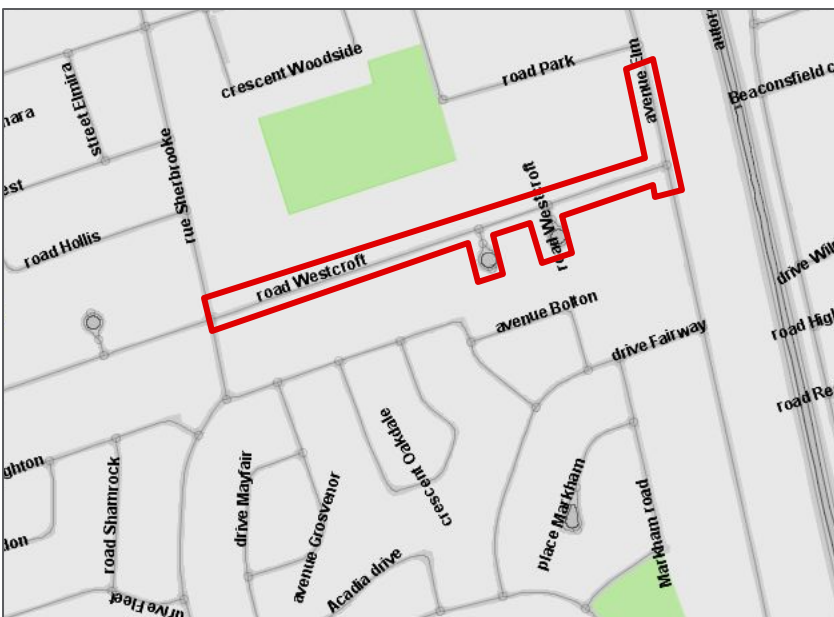
Expected start: week of August 7
**Approximate duration: until
mid-October**

**Rehabilitation work of main and
secondary water pipes**

Traffic and parking

- Local traffic only on:
 - Westcroft Road, between Rue Sherbrooke and Avenue Elm;
 - Avenue Elm, between Fairway Alley and Allancroft Road.
- The intersection of Westcroft Road and Avenue Elm will be completely closed to traffic.
- A cycling detour route will be arranged via Allancroft Road. The highway overpass will remain accessible to cyclists and pedestrians.
- Parking spaces potentially used to provide a security perimeter and to store equipment and materials. Check area signage as it can be modified as required.

Mobility and active travel

- Residences and other buildings accessible at all times;
- Alternative routes for cyclists planned when necessary;
- If you have mobility issues (stroller, crutches, scooter, etc.) contact 514 872-3777.

Temporary water supply system

In order to do these works, there must be no water inside the pipes. A temporary network (a blue and yellow pipe on the ground) will provide you with the water that you need for the duration of the works, without changing its quality.

Two short interruptions (less than 24 hours) will be necessary:

- Before the start of the works, in order to connect your residence to the temporary network;
- At the end of the works, when reconnecting to the main network.

Approximately 48 hours before each interruption, a door sign will indicate the date, time and any other information useful to the concerned residences.

The site:

Schedule and works

- Schedule: Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.;
- Works: a team of experts plans the works and determines the measures to be taken in order to minimize the disturbing aspects of the site (odors, dust, noise, vibrations, etc.) caused by the using of tools and other equipment;
- On garbage, recyclable and compost collection days, place your garbage cans and bins, well-identified with your address, at the usual place. The containers that are not accessible to garbage collectors will be moved by the contractor;
- If you plan to move, do work on your yard, or any other situation for which it is pertinent to inform the site manager, dial 311 to speak to an agent.

Where is the site's team?


Some stages of work and activities that are not visible from outside lead to delays and might give the impression that the works are suspended. During these periods, it is planned that the site's staff be temporarily assigned to another project for efficiency reasons.


Examples :

- Underground works not visible from outside;
- Manufacturing or repairing of a part offsite (in factory);
- Awaiting the results of drinking water tests;
- Electrical functioning tests;
- Construction vacation and holidays;
- Other contingencies, such as adverse weather conditions.
