Temporary Removal of Parking Spaces on Rue Ann Between Rue Ottawa and Rue Dalhousie

Excavation of the William retention facility is now complete. Pipe-laying operations began during the week of January 28. The pipes installed will form the retention structure. The limited space and nearness to other work projects is making it difficult to store pipe sections on site, however.

To facilitate the operations involved in carrying out this phase, parking spaces on Rue Ann, between Rue Ottawa and Rue Dalhousie, will be removed on both sides, on Friday, February 15 and until the end of March, so that the pipes can be stored there.

In order to compensate for the parking spaces removed, additional spaces will be available:

- on Rue Ann, south of Rue Ottawa

Delivery of a prefabricated unit

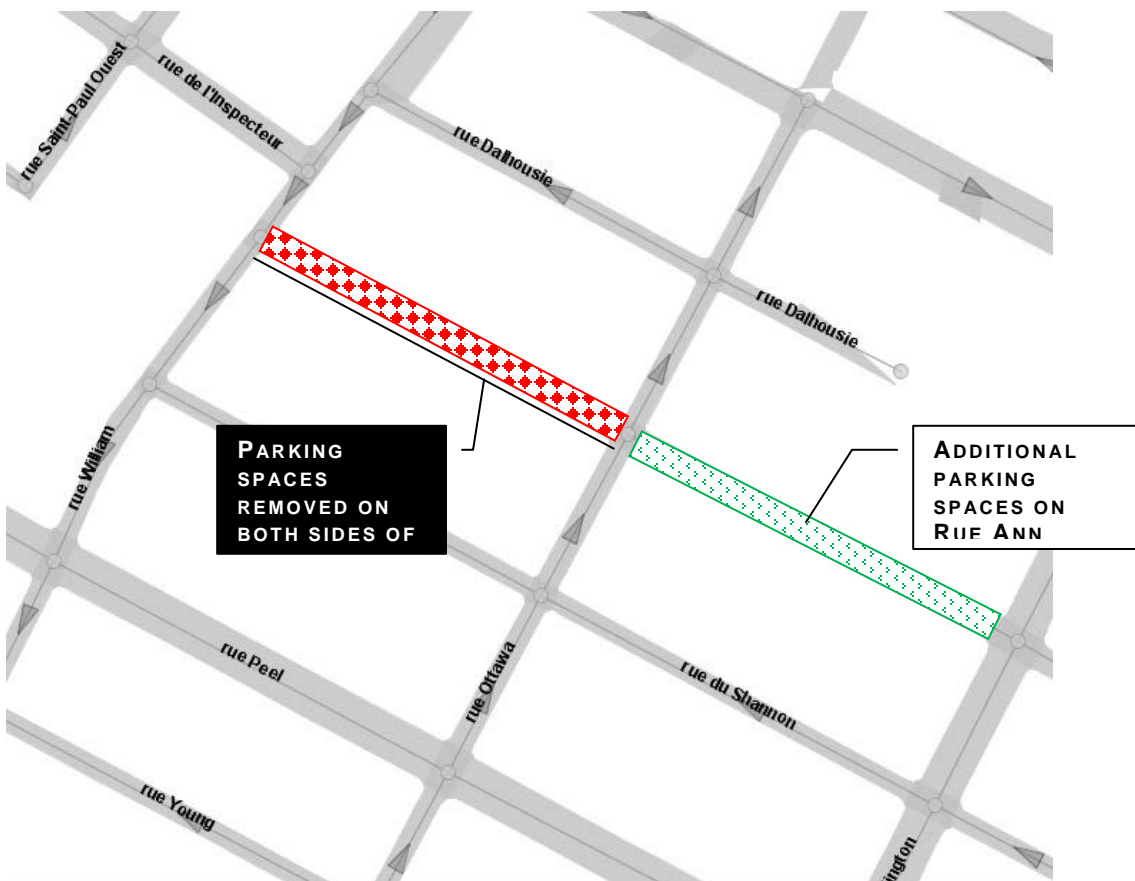
A prefabricated concrete unit will be delivered and installed on **Friday, February 15**. The dimensions and weight of this unit require the use of a crane that must be positioned on Rue William. As a result, a partial obstruction will slow down traffic on Rue William, between Rue Ann and the railway bridge. A flagger will be on site to safely direct pedestrian and motor vehicle traffic.
