Festive weekend in downtown Montréal, June 7 to 10, 2018 – Several traffic obstructions expected

From June 7 to 10, 2018, several major events likely to cause road network disruptions will take place in downtown Montréal.

In order to facilitate travel in this sector, the municipal administration has produced a map indicating street closures and optional itineraries during this period. Also note that as part of the construction of the new Champlain Bridge corridor, traffic obstructions are expected on autoroute 10 in Brossard and autoroute 15 on the island of Montréal.
