You may pay:

- By **Internet**, if this service is available at your financial institution. Enter the 14-digit reference number (without hyphens) shown on the coupon.
- At a counter or at an ATM of your financial institution.
- At any Montréal point of service: payment by debit card, cheque or cash. Please ensure that the point of service accepts cash payment.
- By mail using the enclosed envelope: send the payment coupon with your cheques or money orders payable to **Ville de Montréal**. If no post-dated cheque for the second instalment is included, a reminder with a second coupon will be sent to you in the weeks preceding the due date for the second instalment.

If you disagree with your property assessment, you can request an administrative review before May 1, 2011.
The notice of assessment that the city sent you in November 2010 explains how to file for this review.

Please bear in mind that you must pay your tax bill in full, even if you file for a review.
