



Obituary for Firefighter Thierry Godfrind

Montréal, 17 July 2012, 2 p.m. – The Montreal Fire Department wishes to express its most heartfelt condolences to the family of Firefighter Thierry Godfrind who died in the line of duty on Friday, July 13th 2012 during a fire call.

Serving the residents and visitors of Montreal since 15 March 2010, Firefighter Thierry Godfrind, who was 39 years old and worked at station 42 on group 2, had all the necessary qualities and skills to be an active participant in carrying out the mission and contributing to the evolution of the organisation. Mister Godfrind had the sense of duty and the desire to serve Montrealers to the best of his abilities and convictions. It is with honour and pride that he was welcomed into the ranks of the Montreal Fire Department, and it is with these same feelings that he will be brought to his final place of rest.

Firefighter Godfrind leaves behind his mother Carmen Auger, his father Pierre Godfrind, his sister Nathalie Godfrind (her spouse Pierre Corbeil), his nephews Zachary and Fabien, as well as his girlfriend Julie Bergeron (her son Thomas), friends, brother and sister firefighters.

The funeral will take place on Friday, July 20th 2012, at 11:00 a.m. at the Notre-Dame Basilica of Montreal, located at 110 Notre-Dame Street West. Firefighter Godfrind will lie in repose in the Hall of Honour at Montreal City Hall, located at 275 Notre-Dame Street East, on Wednesday, July 18th 2012 from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., as well as Thursday July 19th 2012 from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
