CONSIDERING THAT a notice of introduction was given at a regular meeting of the city council held on May 28, 2007 (resolution CM07 0311);

CONSIDERING THAT the city council adopted at its regular meeting held on May 28, 2007, draft by-law P-07-023 entitled "By-law amending the Ville de Verdun's Plumbing By-law number 1638" (resolution CM07 0311);

CONSIDERING THAT a public notice was published in Le Magazine de L'Île-des-Soeurs newspaper on Thursday, June 21, 2007, and in Le Messager de Verdun newspaper, on Sunday, June 24, 2007, announcing the public consultation on July 3, 2007, concerning the following draft by-law:

DRAFT BY-LAW P-07-023

By-law amending the Ville de Verdun's Plumbing By-law number 1638 so as to:

- Allow the use of plumbing material permitted under the Quebec Plumbing Code in all buildings within the borough limits with the exception of existing buildings which have a cellar and a building envelope non-compliant with the borough's Building By-law.**
