Mrs. Zizian, a committed volunteer for over ten years, has shown outstanding determination, perseverance and selflessness that have enabled her to maintain and sometimes literally keep afloat—as well as develop the activities of the LaSalle aquatic club, an organization devoted to the well-being of youngsters in the borough of LaSalle. She was so successful in everything she undertook, in fact, that thanks to her, the aquatic club earned the recognition of the *Fédération de natation du Québec* which—for the past eight years—has entrusted the club with organizing the *Championnat provincial par équipe*, a crucial activity for the club's financial health and maintaining its influence on the provincial scene.

If there is one aspect of which Mrs. Zizian is particularly proud, it's the fact that the club reaches out to young swimmers with various profiles: "Here the youngsters can come and learn to swim, to compete or just train. What we're looking for, first and foremost, is to get them interested in physical activity. And that will stay with them all throughout their life."
