Further to this consultation of March 31, 2008, I am requesting written clarification and response to the following issues.

1. budget for each maison including the sources of funding
2. budget for the infrastructure for each maison, including costs of installing fire hydrants, costs of installing pipes to the river and lake, costs of installing security system, costs of redoing the plumbing and heating system
3. who is going to use these buildings
4. what concrete steps is the city or conseil planning to take to protect the shore line of these properties, the trees and shrubbery
5. How much money has the City of Montreal made from the rental of the park and buildings during the fiscal year 2007, 2006. I note that many film companies have rented parts of this park, and I wish to find out whether this money goes for the planting of trees, maintenance of this natural space, or if it goes into general revenue.

I am requesting cooperation in addressing these concerns from a global or integrated perspective. I am a tax payer in Montreal and I use this park in summer and winter.
