

To the Hon^{ble} the Mayor, Alderman
and Citizens of the City of Montreal

The undersigned Petitioners, Proprietors
in the St. Ann's Suburbs and others, interested in
perfecting a Communication with the port of the City,
by the principal Street in that Section of the Town,
and understanding that the Corporation contemplates
opening McGill Street to the River, they would
most respectfully, yet earnestly, recommend, that
measures may be taken, at the same time, for the
purpose of continuing Wellington Street to the Harbour,

In urging this measure, on the favourable
consideration of the Corporation the Petitioners
conceive that its early execution is so self evident,
that any elaborate argument, for the purpose
of showing its absolute necessity would be superfluous.
Still it may not be perhaps, trespassing too far, to
direct the attention of the Corporation, to the great
inconvenience that must necessarily arise to the
inhabitants of a Street, that is destined, at no
distant days, to be second to no one in the City,
for its commercial rank and elegance, if its
immediate entrance to the Port is to be incommoded
by the necessity of turning a couple of right angles,
within a few paces of each other, to say nothing of
the danger and unsightly appearance that a cluster
of Streets present, abruptly terminated by the crossing
of other Streets, obstructions of this nature are far
too numerous already, in Montreal,

The confidence that your Petitioners repose
in the ability and integrity of your Body, assures
them that, if the premises are duly examined, strict
justice will be done, and your Petitioners ask
for nothing more, and as in duty bound will
ever pray &c &c &c
