Service info-logement

Since 1998, the Service Info-logement of the Centre de réadaptation Lucie-Bruneau has centralized and coordinated the supply and demand of rental apartments that are accessible and available for handicapped people with reduced mobility in the regions of Montreal, Laval and the South Shore.

Service info-logement...

- Facilitates the search for apartments accessible for handicapped people.
- Increases the visibility of those who own accessible rental apartments or wish to make their apartments accessible.
- Maximizes the return on the investments made by the SAAQ, the SHQ (Home Adaptation Program), the CSST, private insurers, owners, etc. who subsidize the adaptation of apartments.

Renters

Are you looking for an accessible apartment?

- Contact us by telephone at 514-376-4757, extension 2222, to complete the apartment application form with us, register for the service and describe your needs.

Then...

- Our team will contact you as soon as an apartment that satisfies your criteria becomes available. You will have to handle the subsequent steps yourself (visit, lease, etc.).
- Please tell us how your search works out in order to help us keep our information up-to-date.

N.B.: The apartments are classified in keeping with the information provided through the questionnaire. It should be noted that none of them have been visited. Your cooperation is essential for validating the information provided by the owners.

Owners

Do you want to offer an accessible apartment?

- Contact us by telephone at 514-376-4757, extension 2222, to complete the general rental information form with us and provide specific information about the accessibility of the apartment.

Then...

- We will contact you each month to update our list.
- You must notify us when you lease an apartment and give us the name of tenant so that we can keep our list up-to-date.
