

Chalet du Mont-Royal - Technical data sheet

■ Special features



Salle des pas perdus

■ Characteristics

- Height of ceilings: approx. 30 ft. (between floor and metal beams)
- Six dimmable light fixtures
- Lighting system for historical paintings
- Sound system (for mood music only)
- Gaz fireplace

■ Electricity

- Possibibility of installing 200 single-phase amperes and 200 triphase amperes (camlock or electrical distribution panel) at the three locations indicated on the plan.
- 15 double electrical outlets (15 amperes) integrated into the heaters or positioned directly on the floor.
- 28 electrical outlets (20 amperes) (twist-lock connector assembly for two plugs) on an independent circuit around the room.

■ Ceiling suspensions

- Sound and lighting equipment must be installed on the anchorage provided for this purpose, i.e. between the purlins and beams or between the purlins and rafters.
- Maximum load of 227 kg (500 lbs) per anchorage. A maximum of five loads of 227 kg suspended simultaneously. Four anchorages in the southeast zone cannot be used. The roof can support a maximum load of 0.5 kPa (10 lb. / sq. ft).
- The electric winch located in front of the fireplace can support a maxi mum load of 680 kg (1,500 lb.).

■ Handling of tools and materials

To preserve the good condition of the chalet:

- All direct contact between the marble floor and heavy objects and equipment must be avoided by installing neoprene or rubber cushions. To transport such items, the use of carts and hand trucks equipped with rubber tires is required.
- Particular attention must be paid to doors, doorframes and walls so as to avoid causing damage during handling.
- The use of adhesive tape, nails, screws and staples on the floors and walls is prohibited.

Additional services

In order to steer guests to the Smith House parking lot (no. 117), you are allowed to set up sandwich board signs starting at the following intersections on the day of the event:

- Avenue du Mont-Royal / voie Camilien-Houde
- Chemin de la Côte-des-Neiges / chemin Remembrance

Eight sandwich board signs measuring 36 inches high by 24 inches wide are provided for posters. All posters have to be water resistant and delivered to 1800 Chemin Remembrance one week prior to the event.
