Reconstruction of sewer pipes, water mains and road infrastructures on Marcel-Laurin between Saint-Louis and the Décarie expressway access ramps

Dear Sir or Madam,

The Ville de Montréal will be rebuilding sewer pipes, water mains and road infrastructures on Marcel-Laurin between Saint-Louis and the Décarie expressway access ramps. Work will also be done on Saint-Louis, between Tait and Marcel-Laurin.

The work involves rebuilding the sewer pipes and the secondary water main, along with sidewalks, the median island and pavement on Marcel-Laurin. Lighting will be upgraded and a storm sewer will also be built on the same section of the street. In addition, a storm sewer will be installed on Saint-Louis.

The work should begin in the week of April 11, 2016 and continue until the end of October 2016.

Water shutoff

A temporary fresh water supply system will be installed for this project, and the water supply will be interrupted at times during the work. Door hangers will be distributed 48 hours before the shutoff, indicating the precise start and end times. Please pay close attention to these notices.

Traffic and parking

During the work period:

- Two-way traffic will be maintained on Marcel-Laurin at all times.
- During some work, Saint-Louis will be completely closed to traffic.

Traffic will be restricted and parking will be prohibited at and around the work site.

Pedestrian access to homes and businesses situated near the site will be maintained at all times. Please obey the signs at the site.

Work schedule

The work teams will be on-site from Monday to Friday, from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Some work may be done during the evening and at night on weekdays and weekends.

Garbage and recycling collection

Although garbage and recycling will be collected according to the usual schedule, it is important that everyone identify their bins so that they can be returned to the right home or business.

Public transport
