**The future of the manufacturing sector in Montréal**

The *Commission sur le développement économique et urbain et l'habitation* invites the population to take part in a public consultation regarding the future of the manufacturing sector in Montréal. This consultation will allow the *Service du développement économique* to present an analysis of the current state of the manufacturing sector in Montréal as well as certain emerging practices. Citizens and representatives of organizations and institutions will be invited to share with committee members their opinions on the content of the presentation and their thoughts on how to revitalize this sector of the economy.
