

WHAT IS THE THREE-YEAR CAPITAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (TYCP)?

- ☐ Investment in capital assets
- Maintenance of asset quality
- Development of key sectors
- Capitalization of expenses
- Spending financed by a loan by-law

Examples:

- Converting wading pools to water play parks
- Park playground renovations
- Local street repairs

At least 75% for protection and up to 25% for development.
