

Redevelopment of Place du 375e, Next to Côte-Vertu Metro Station

Starting early September, 2016, the Borough of Saint-Laurent will be carrying out work to redevelop Édouard-Laurin municipal parking lot, bounded by Décarie, Édouard-Laurin and Gohier, next to Côte-Vertu metro station.

The purpose of this work project is to create a new public square within the legacy of Montréal's 375th anniversary. Greenery will be added to create a cool area. Spaces for sitting will be set up and the lighting will be improved. The transit and meeting functions will be maintained: the square will remain a drop-off point, buses will continue to pass along here and bicycle racks will be installed. This new square will be adaptable to many different uses: a public market, kiosks, a café, tai-chi, etc.

Work schedule

The work will get under way on September 6 and is expected to be completed by the end of this year. The crews will normally work 7 a.m. – 5 p.m., Monday – Friday; however, if necessary, they may occasionally work on Saturdays and Sundays as well.

As a result, Gohier and Édouard-Laurin will be closed around the worksite.

Relocation of bus stops

The bus stops located on Gohier, between Côte-Vertu and Édouard-Laurin as well as those on Édouard-Laurin have been relocated further north (northern terminus of Côte-Vertu metro station entrance).

Relocation of bus routes

Due to this work project, bus routes will be relocated on certain nearby streets that are not normally used by the STM. Buses will therefore be passing along the following streets:

- Rochon, between Crevier and Sainte-Croix
- Cardinal, between Côte-Vertu and Rochon
- Crevier, between Côte-Vertu and Rochon
- Sainte-Croix, between Côte-Vertu and Rochon

Municipal parking

People accustomed to using the Édouard-Laurin parking lot are reminded that the Ouimet Nord or Ouimet Sud municipal parking lots are located nearby.

Access to commercial establishments

Access to commercial establishments in the neighbourhood will be maintained at all times.
