### PUBLIC CONSULTATION

## DESIGNING BUILDINGS WITHIN A PERSPECTIVE OF SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT ON THE TERRITORY OF VILLE DE MONTRÉAL

The <u>Commission permanente sur l'eau, l'environnement, le développement durable et les grands parcs</u> (standing committee on water, the environment, sustainable development and large parks) will hold a public consultation regarding the approach the city wishes to adopt in order to integrate the principles of sustainable development to buildings on its territory.

As the concept of sustainable buildings refers to a wide range of elements, the committee invites the population to reflect on regulations and other municipal tools that concern certain specific elements that have a significant influence on the sustainability of the built environment and upon which the city may act, such as the development of white or green roofs, the adoption of energy efficiency measures, the management of residual materials and rainwater and the application of universal accessibility principles.

The public consultation will be held in three parts. The first, an information session, will be intended for the presentation of the consultation document, as well as for public questions. The second part will be the hearing of opinions and briefs. The adoption of recommendations by the committee will be the object of the third part.
