PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Towards a social development policy

The <u>Commission sur le développement social et la diversité montréalaise</u> invites the public to participate in a public consultation concerning the social development policy draft. This consultation will start with a public information session on **November 15, 2016**, at city hall.

City representatives are presently working on the development of this policy. Their objectives are namely to identify the guidelines for actions to be taken over the next few years, as well as to promote coherency in interventions between the city and its partners. This consultation aims at providing the city with a new policy in 2017.
