CHANGES TO COLLECTION DAYS ACROSS BOROUGH TERRITORY


RENEWAL OF CONTRACTS

In order to ensure quality service at the best possible cost, the Sud-Ouest Borough will change the collection schedules for food waste (compost) and heavy objects (large objects, household appliances, furniture as well as construction, renovation and demolition waste) starting on April 1, 2017. The collection of recyclable materials and household garbage will also change for 20% of households.

Two steps to follow

Place your collection items on the curb in front of your home on the morning of the collection between 5 a.m. and 8 a.m. The materials will be collected by different trucks, depending on the type of collection, during the day.
