At its meeting of April 24, 2017 (session of April 25), city council adopted, by resolution CM17 0498, the draft by-law titled *By-law concerning the transfer for the purposes of establishing, maintaining and improving parks and playgrounds, and of preserving natural areas on city territory.*

Object of the draft by-law

The draft by-law aims at establishing the payment of park fees in the case of redevelopment projects for residential purposes.

There are no provisions in this draft by-law specific to a by-law that is subject to approval by way of referendum.
