PUBLIC CONSULTATION

Urban sports and outdoor activity action plan

The <u>Commission permanente sur la culture, le patrimoine et les sports</u> invites citizens to take part in a public consultation on the city's draft urban sports and outdoor activity action plan 2018-2028.

Following the *Plan directeur du sport et du plein air urbains* prepared between 2013 and 2018, this draft action plan proposes concrete measures to create environments designed to promote a physically active lifestyle in Montréal and to improve access to parks, public places, pedestrian streets, playgrounds and sports fields.

The consultation will allow the metropolis to adopt, in the fall of 2018, a final action plan that will meet the needs and aspirations of Montrealers.

There are two ways to take part in this consultation:

- By answering the online survey, available at <u>realisonsmtl.ca/sport</u>. This survey will directly influence the opinions of committee members.
- By presenting a brief or opinion to the committee during one of the four planned public meetings. Consultations will be held as follows:
