ENVIRONMENTALLY-FRIENDLY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR CLOTH DIAPERS

Environmentally-friendly financial assistance program for families in the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro to encourage the use of cloth (washable) baby diapers

Within the scope of Ville de Montréal's Sustainable Development Plan, the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro has established a financial assistance program in cooperation with VertCité, as part of the Pierrefonds-Roxboro *éco-quartier* program, to encourage the use of cloth diapers.

Financial assistance of up to \$100 per applicant will be offered to residents participating in the cloth diaper financial assistance program (maximum funds totalling \$4,500).

TO QUALIFY:

- 1. Be a resident of the borough of Pierrefonds-Roxboro
- 2. Be a parent of a child under 12 months old (at time of application for financial assistance)
- Submit the <u>supporting documents</u>, along with your application, to the Éco-quartier Pierrefonds-Roxboro.

LIST OF SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- 1. Application form duly completed and signed by parent(s)
- 2. Proof of residence (driver's licence or one of the following documents: public utility bill [Bell Canada, Hydro-Québec, Gaz Métro, Vidéotron, etc.], statement of account of an educational institution [tuition fees], bank statement, employment insurance or income security cheque stub, hospital card [if the address is marked on it and if the card is still valid])
- 3. Proof of your child's birth:
 - copy of birth certificate
 - · confirmation of registration of birth in the register of civil status
 - copy of baby's health insurance card or hospital card
- 4. Original bill for a set of new cloth diapers or cloth diaper service and all original bills covering a period of 12 months from January 1 to December 31, 2019 for full cloth diaper service.
