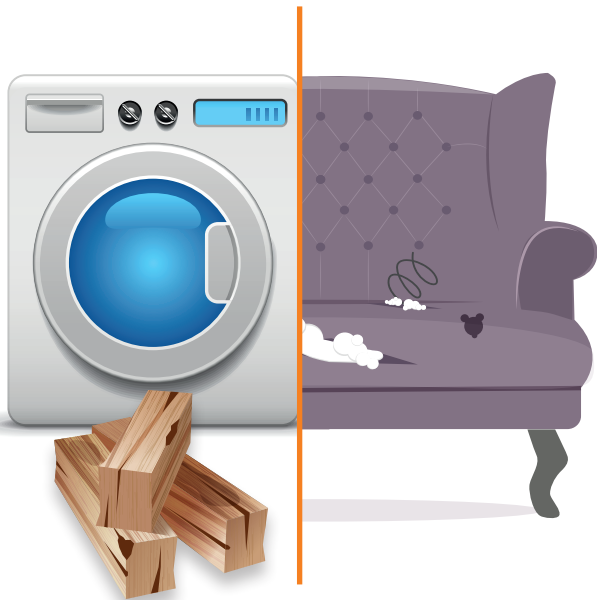


# BULKY ITEMS COLLECTION

The Borough of Saint-Laurent offers its residents a collection that enables them to dispose of their bulky items.

This collection is carried out once a month, according to the schedule for each collection sector.

Since they are loaded onto two separate trucks (according to their type), bulky items must be placed in **two different piles** for collection:

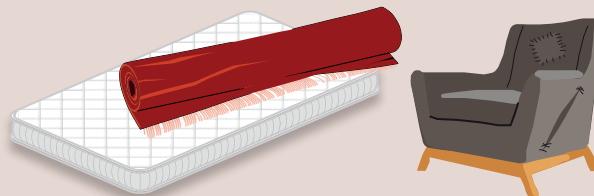
## 1 Non-upholstered bulky items and construction, renovation and demolition (CRD) debris

- Furniture made of wood, metal or any other recyclable material (ex.: tables, chairs, drawers and shelving units)
- Household appliances (excluding refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners)
- Toilets, bathtubs and sinks
- Wood (without any nails or screws)
- Brick, mortar, ceramic and flat glass
- Siding materials and drywall
- Rigid plastics and large cardboard boxes



## 2 Upholstered bulky items

- Upholstered furniture (ex.: sofas, armchairs and chairs)
- Mattresses and box springs
- Carpets and rugs



## Pass it on!

Articles that are in good condition may be useful to other people in the community. Think about offering them to organizations or companies that will pass them on to others.

## Banned materials

Household waste, organic waste and green waste must only be disposed of in the collections provided for these types of materials.

Appliances containing refrigerant gases (ex.: refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners) are subject to a special collection by the Borough. A request must be made by calling 311.

The following materials and articles are not accepted in any of the Borough's collections and must be brought to an ecocentre:

- Tires
- Hazardous household waste (ex.: paint, oil, cleaning products, batteries, pesticides, chlorine, solvents, flammable liquids, fluorescent tubes and bulbs)
- Electronic products (ex.: televisions, computers, printers, sound systems, DVD players and cellphones)
