Garage Sale



You'd like to get rid of a lot of things you're no longer using and you're thinking that you're sure to find a buyer at a garage sale? Just follow the guidelines contained in this pamphlet, to put these items on display while complying with the rules.

I make plans

The sale must be held between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. and not last more than two consecutive days. In addition, only two garage sales are authorized per year for the same address.

I have my permit

You must obtain a certificate of authorization (\$10) at the Accès-LaSalle office, located at 55 avenue Dupras (tel.: 514 367-1000). To obtain it, you must provide the following information: the owner's name and address and his written authorization if you're the tenant as well as the date and time of the sale.

Once you have obtained your certificate, you will then be able to go ahead with your garage sale.



I advertise

To advertise your garage sale, you are allowed to post one single sign, no larger than one square metre. This sign may be installed only on your own property and no more than 4 days before the event. It is prohibited to post a sign on public utility poles and street lights in the Borough. Don't forget this rule, as offenders are liable to a fine of \$100.
