Notice to Outremont residents New parking plan

For a greener borough, to prioritize residents and promote safer active transportation

The plan will be implemented in stages, by neighbourhood, over the coming weeks and calls for:

- The end of alternate-day parking in order to introduce safer streetscaping design;
- Parking is permitted for a maximum of two hours between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. and is free of charge from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Outside these periods, a vignette is required and will be valid across the entire borough territory. Annual, monthly and daily vignettes are available.
- Pay-parking areas governed by meters are unchanged.

Please note that the street cleaning period remains in effect from April to November.

If you wish to park your vehicle on the street for more than two hours during the day, you need to purchase a vignette. Please see the chart on the other side for more information on vignettes. A complete guide will also be delivered to your door soon.

Changes in your neighbourhood

Replacement of parking signs on streets is currently underway and will continue gradually over the coming weeks.

<u>IMPORTANT</u>

In order to facilitate the transition for residents, there will be grace period until the end of December 2019. It will apply only in two-hour-maximum parking zones, except during street-cleaning hours.

Please not that this grace period will not apply in zones where signs indicate no parking at any time, during snow-clearing operations and during the street cleaning period.

Effective January 3, 2020, any vehicle parked illegally will be ticketed and fined.
