

# Notice to Outremont residents

## New parking plan

For a greener borough, to prioritize residents  
and promote safer active transportation

The plan will be implemented in stages, by neighbourhood, over the coming weeks and calls for:

- The end of alternate-day parking in order to introduce safer streetscaping design;
- Parking is permitted for a maximum of two hours between 8 a.m. and 10 p.m. and is free of charge from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Outside these periods, a vignette is required and will be valid across the entire borough territory. Annual, monthly and daily vignettes are available.
- Pay-parking areas governed by meters are unchanged.

**Please note that the street cleaning period  
remains in effect from April to November.**

If you wish to park your vehicle on the street for more than two hours during the day, you need to purchase a vignette. Please see the chart on the other side for more information on vignettes. A complete guide will also be delivered to your door soon.

### **Changes in your neighbourhood**

Replacement of parking signs on streets is currently underway and will continue gradually over the coming weeks.

## **IMPORTANT**

In order to facilitate the transition for residents, there will be grace period until the end of December 2019. It will apply only in two-hour-maximum parking zones, except during street-cleaning hours.

**Please note that this grace period will not apply in zones where signs indicate no parking at any time, during snow-clearing operations and during the street cleaning period.**

Effective January 3, 2020, any vehicle parked illegally will be ticketed and fined.
